NFP Incentive Fund Awards Will Help Local Communities Serve More Vulnerable Families

DENVER, CO (February 21, 2019) — The Nurse-Family Partnership National Service Office announced that it has awarded over \$13.5 million to expand its reach to serve more vulnerable families and impact local communities across the country. This initiative is part of Nurse-Family Partnership's strategic plan to double the number of families served by 2023. These Incentive Fund Awards will add over 80 new Nurse-Family Partnership ® nurses to serve more than 1,800 moms.

The Nurse-Family Partnership National Service Office presented these Incentive Fund Awards to local network partners that have been successfully changing outcomes for moms and babies in poverty. These awards will also support the launch of three new local Nurse-Family Partnership programs.

"Nurse-Family Partnership is excited to launch this new initiative to reach more families in need," said Frank Daidone, president and CEO of Nurse-Family Partnership. "We congratulate our local network partners that have been successful in growing their nursing teams to reach more families and boost our collective impact."

Incentive funding was made possible through generous philanthropic support and provides funding to local network partners to expand local Nurse-Family Partnership programs over three years.
