94% MOTHERS INITIATED BREASTFEEDING

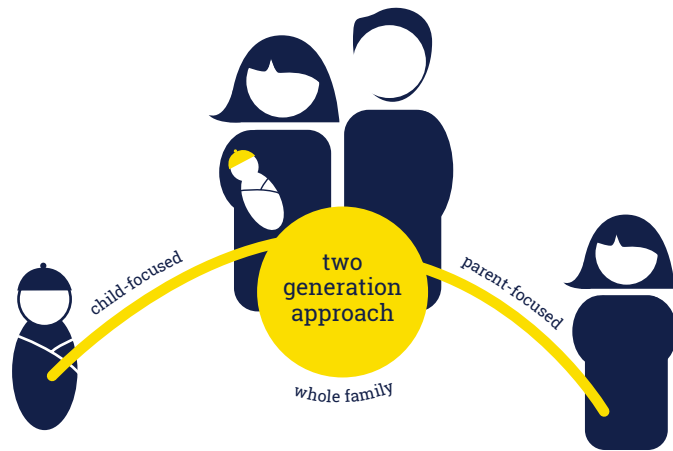
93% BABIES RECEIVED ALL IMMUNIZATIONS BY 24 MONTHS

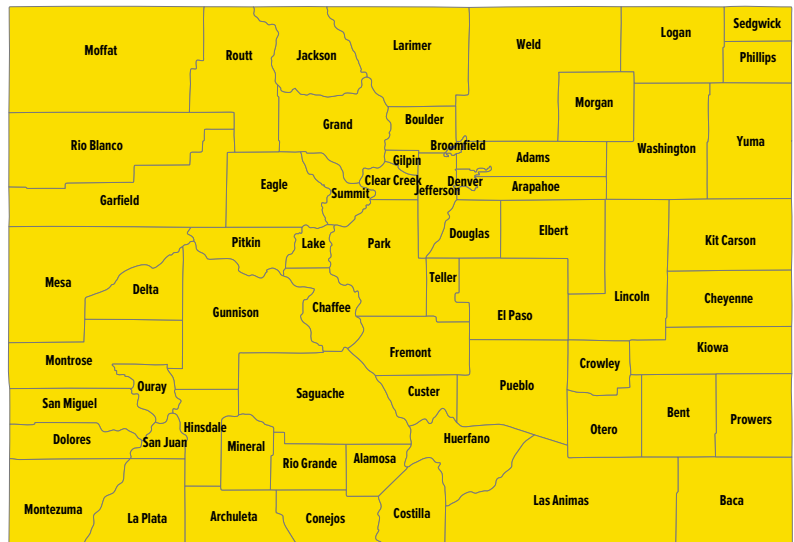
